




Glenfarclas Malt Mill

Capacity of 8 Tonnes per Hour





Statement from John L S Grant before the first release of the Family Casks collection in 2007

- •It is pride and a sense of history which leads us to create a collection of limited edition Glenfarclas expressions —The Family Casks.
- •Thanks to the foresight of my late father, George S Grant, we are in a rather enviable position that today we have casks from every year since 1953. I'm not aware of another distillery with stock from so many consistent years.
- •It is our intention to bottle the very best of these casks with at least one from each year at cask strength and natural colour.
- •We are doing this for two reasons. Firstly, because we can and, secondly, because we thought it would be rather fun.
- •When The Family Casks collection is complete, it will be the biggest possible vertical tasting of Glenfarclas expressions.
- •We have now completed the bottling of 300 single casks under the name THE FAMILY CASKS

We continue to release a new bottling of each vintage from 1954 to 2002 each year, selecting our very best casks from our traditional warehouses and bottling our favourites.
